The island holds internationally significant breeding populations of:

- > Roseate tern
- > Arctic tern
- > Common tern
- > Sandwich tern

It supports the largest single breeding population of Roseate tern in Britain

The site regularly supports over

47,000 individual breeding

**seabirds**, including nationally important numbers of:

- > Puffin
- > Black-head gull

The breeding birds of Coquet Island use the adjacent Northumberland Marine SPA for foraging.
