

Northumberland Marine Special Protection Area (SPA)

Stretches 41 miles in length from Berwick upon Tweed to Blyth and extends 12 miles out to sea at its furthest point.

The Northumberland Marine SPA is designated to protect the feeding and resting areas used by internationally significant populations of:

- > Arctic tern
- > Common tern
- > Little tern
- > Roseate tern
- > Sandwich tern
- > Puffin
- > Common guillemot

The site regularly supports more than 200,000 seabirds

each year, making it the 2nd

largest breeding seabird assemblage in England.
