

Northumbria Coast Special Protection Area (SPA)

The site stretches from north of Holy Island down to Crimdon in County Durham and mostly consists of discrete sections of rocky shore.

The site supports internationally significant wintering numbers of two species of wader:

- > Purple sandpiper
- > Turnstone

Both of these species are largely restricted to areas of rocky shore.

It is also designated for breeding populations of:

- > Little tern
- > Arctic tern

The breeding birds of the Northumbria **Coast use the adjacent Northumberland** Marine SPA for foraging.
