# Projects: Championing Coastal Coordination (3Cs)

Project run jointly with Durham Heritage Coast

- Looked at regional response to likely climate change impacts on the coast
- 4 workshops with 68 stakeholders from 41 organisations held February-March this year
- Creation of Regional Coastal Network covering Berwickshire and North East England


